### Growing Passionfruit Seeds

Growing passionfruit seeds is not hard.

- For some reason old seed takes a lot longer to germinate. They take about ten to twenty days to germinate.
- Older passionfruit seeds can take months to germinate. The best way seems to be to just put them in the garden and leave them be, and eventually they come up.
- There are some tricks like soaking the seeds in warm water first, and some people swear by vinegar. Others report their acidic soil seems to do the job.
- Use a seed raising mix, fill the tray (container) to 5 mm from the top.
- Press down firmly on the mix, use a piece of flat wood.
- Place the seed on top of the mix and cover with vermiculite.
- The seed should start to appear in 2 – 3 weeks.
- Do NOT over water till they have germinated.
